- 3. PARKING: Please use the trailer park beyond the bottom paddock, and below the Motorhomes. Please do not park in the Officials/Camping field by the start line or in any of the farmyard.
- 4. SIGNING ON will start at 7.30am Saturday when drivers competition licence, and entrants licence where applicable, will be inspected. Double drives are prefixed **7 or 9. Please note:-** Would double drives please indicate on arrival in the top paddock by raising their arm in order that the paddock marshals can park them appropriately.
